

Preparing your Solar Light for Winter

Extreme cold weather can drastically reduce the life expectancy of your rechargeable NiCd or NiMH batteries. Remove the batteries from the light unit before storing them indoors.



- Allow the batteries to charge for at least a full day of direct sunlight before removing the batteries.
 - Remove the batteries before nightfall.
 - Store the batteries, screws, battery cover, and any additional accessories in a dry location at room temperature.

- Clean the solar panel with a non-abrasive cleaner, such as Windex™ or car wax (Novus™ or Meguiar's™) and a cotton cloth.
 - Clear the underside of the solar light of any dirt, cobwebs, or moisture.
 - Store the light in a dry location at room temperature.
